Provision of social amenities such as schools, clinics and water supply. 2. Provision of relief services to assist rural communities. 3. Empowerment of women. 4. Environmental protection. 5. Protection of human rights. DIMENSION Application of knowledge. PROBLEMS FACING N.G.O.'S IN GHANA 1. The majority of N.G.O.'s in Ghana lack funds to be able to operate effectively. 2. Government interference in the activities of N.G.O.'s often frustrates their work. 3. Some N.G.O.'s do not have the needed skilled personnel to work with and sometimes have to fall on untrained persons to carry out their activities. 4. Some N.G.O.'s do not have the needed inputs such as vehicles, computers and other pieces of equipment to work with. DIMENSION Application of knowledge.	Pupils to answer the following questions.
